The year 2017 was another record breaker for your credit union. Assets increased by over \$31 million, loans increased by almost \$28 million and net income also hit a new high of more than \$2.3 million dollars. The primary reason for this is the continued loyalty of our 27,000+ friends and neighbors — our members.

After spending part of the past two years working on acquiring the old Key Bank building in Tenino, the credit union finally celebrated its new

location in the fall. Designed by our staff, this branch was inspired by the Olympia Brewery's tasting room and was so unique it was even featured on local TV news. This theme will be expanded and will continue into 0 Bee's future.

The coming year will again show progress as the credit union launches its first branch outside of Thurston county in Ruston. This branch should open around summertime.

I wish to thank the volunteers, the staff and especially the membership for making 0 Bee what it is — one of the best credit unions in the country.






